The Inchgarth community garden has been recently renovated by our volunteer Bryan who has tirelessly worked on it since the middle of last year.

Updates include the addition of a fresh fruit and vegetable patch and a colourful and diverse flowerbed. The boxes for our vegetables have also been kindly created by people from the community and all the crops are recycled with nothing going to waste.

In April, 20 volunteers from Kellas Midstream came to further develop the garden and make it a place accessible for all with ramps for wheelchairs and some surrounding safety fencing for young children. Bryan hopes to see **“anyone and everyone enjoy nature”** in the newly revitalised green patch.
